Unpack the unit and confirm that you have all the parts listed. Assemble the unit on a solid level surface, avoid carpet. You will need the assistance of a second person during assembly.


You will need the following: Rubber Mallet or Hammer.


Parts List Part B - Long Beams x 10 Part C - Short Beams x 10 Part F-Rubber Feet Part D - Braces x 10 Part E-Wire Shelving x 5 Angle Posts x 4



Step 1: Assembling bottom of frame

Add Rubber Feet (Part F) to bottom of Angle Posts (Part A). Slot Short Beams (Part C) to the bottom of the Angle Posts (Part A) as shown, followed by Long Beams (Part B) to opposing keyholes (in holes 2nd and 3rd from bottom). NOTE: Flat edges face outwards.

Lock rivets to the bottom of the keyhole by tapping the Beams with a Rubber Mallet.




Step 2: Assembling remaining frame

Fasten Short Beams (Part C) to the top of the Angle Posts (Part A) as shown, followed by Long Beams (Part B) to opposing keyholes to form the frame.


NOTE: Flat edges face outwards.

Lock rivets to the bottom of the keyhole by tapping the Beams with a Rubber Mallet.




Step 3: Assemble remaining shelving

Assemble remaining Short Beams (Part C) and Long Beams (Part B) to your desired shelf height. As before, lock rivets to the bottom of the keyhole by tapping the Beams with a Rubber Mallet.



Step 4: Slot Braces (Part D) into position through the holes provided on the Long Beams (Part B).



Step 5: Lay the Wire Shelving (Part E) between the Beams as shown
