


HOW DOES THE GECKO INSECT KILLER WORK?

Mosquitoes, moths and other pests are attracted to UV and other light sources.

Gecko Insect Killers feature specially designed UV lamps that generate a UV wavelength designed for maximu luring power.

As insects are lured into the unit they come into contact with the electrically charged high voltage grid. They a electrocuted and drop into the collection tray at the bottom of the unit.

Gecko Zappers comply with Australia and New Zealand Standards. AS/NZS 60335.2.59.





When using electric appliances always observe safety regulations to reduce the risk of fire, electric shock a personal injury. Always check that the power supply corresponds to the voltage on the rating label on t appliance.

Cord and plug

Always unplug the appliance from mains supply when not in use. Do not abuse or damage the power cord the supply cord is damaged, it must be replaced by the manufacturer or its service agent or a similarly qualifie person in order to avoid hazard.

Repair

For any repair needs, please take appliance to an authorised repairer or qualified person.

USAGE ENVIRONMENT

Children and/or Infirm Persons

CAUTION. Keep out of reach of children or infirm persons. *This appliance is not intended for use by perso (including children) with reduced physical, sensory or mental capabilities, or lack of experience and knowledg unless they have been given supervision or instruction concerning use of the appliance by a person responsib for their safety. Children should be supervised to ensure that they do not play with the appliance.*

Water

DO NOT IMMERSE THE APPLIANCE IN WATER.

Do not immerse any part of this appliance or supply cord in water. Do not use with wet hands or use in dam situations.

Access

DANGER - HIGH VOLTAGE. Do not put any object inside or attempt to touch any internal components. Ensu children do not play with the appliance or attempt to stick fingers or other objects through the safety gril Insects should only be cleaned from the unit while disconnected from the mains supply, with the supplie brush.

Disconnect the unit from the mains by unplugging it before any cleaning or maintenance is carried out.

GENERAL SAFETY

WARNING: This unit is for indoor use only. When using extension cords, keep the socket-outlet away fro moisture and avoid damage to the cord.

When using electric appliances basic safety precautions should always be followed to reduce the risk of fir electric shock and personal injury. Read all these instructions before attempting to use the appliance.

1. Keep children away

This appliance is not intended for use by young children or infirm persons without supervision. Young childre must be supervised to ensure that they do not play with this product. Safely dispose of any packagin including plastic bags.

2. Personal Injury

Keep hands and other body parts away from internal parts. Do not put fingers or any other objects through the safety grille.

3. Damaged or dropped

Always inspect your appliance before use. Check that all parts are correctly attached. Do not use this applian if it has been damaged, dropped, left outdoors or dropped in water. Return it to an authorised service dealer f examination and repair.

4. Store in a safe place

When not in use, store your appliance and all its accessories and instruction manual in a safe and dry place

5. Flammable vapour or explosive dust.

The appliance is not to be used in locations where flammable vapour or explosive dust is likely to exist. Do not use in barns stables and similar locations



Location and use

The Insect Killer is best located away from human activity and hung at a height of around 2.5 metres. It is recommended that the appliance be used continuously when people and pets are present. Ensure the unit is placed away from other light sources. Keep away from the reach of small children or hang using the attached hanging harness. Connect the plug to a suitable power supply, corresponding to that of the appliance, 230VAC, 50/60Hz.

To operate, ensure the unit is plugged in and switched on at a suitable power point. Point the remote control at your Zapper and push the ON button briefly. To switch off, point the remote control at your Zapper and push the OFF button briefly. Ensure the remote control is stored in a cool, dry place. Do not leave it in direct sunlight or in a hot (> 30° C) environment for extended periods, as this may cause the unit to fail and void its warranty. Use 12V Alkaline battery 23A.

Insect disposal and general maintenance

Regular maintenance of your appliance will keep it safe and in proper working order.

1. Before cleaning and maintenance

When not in use or before cleaning, always disconnect the appliance from the mains supply.

Wait 1 minute before starting to clean. Do not remove protective grid cover when the appliance is connected to mains power supply.

2. Cleaning

Remove bottom tray by sliding outwards (Figure 2) and empty dead insects from the tray. If needed use supplied cleaning brush. As the high voltage grid is a vertical design, it should require minimal cleaning. For optimal performance, it's recommended that the unit is inspected and cleaned if necessary once per week. Do not use metal objects or stick fingers through outer casing. Regularly clean the outside of the appliance with a soft damp cloth and dry it with a towel. Do not immerse in water. Do not use harsh solvents to clean the plastic.

3. Ventilation

Always allow adequate ventilation for the appliance. Failure to do so may result in overheating.

4. Damage check


Always check that the appliance is in good working condition and all guards are secure. Check the power supply cord and plug regularly for damage.

5. Lamp Replacement

IMPORTANT: Before replacing lamp, unplug unit from mains power.

- 1. Remove catcher tray from bottom of unit (Figure 2).
- 2. Unscrew Safety Clips on side of unit to release grill (Figure 3).
- 3. Unscrew metal retaining clips at base of metal grill, release grill.
- 4. Gently remove and replace the lamp using lamp COM41G (Figure 4).
- 5. Reassemble unit.
