
ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTION FOR UNIT






Step 1: Lay all panels on the floor to assemble.


Step 2: Secure Left Gable (1) to Top Shelf (3), then the Base Shelf (4).

Step 3: Ensure all Shelves are attached to the Left Gable, then secure the Right Gable (2) to all 2 Shelves. Ensure you follow the below cam instructions and use 4 x Cam Locks and Pins per shelf.

Step 4: When this is all completed cam the Kick Face (5) to the Base Shelf (4).




ASSEMBLY BACKING BOARD



Step 5: Proceed to nail the Backing Board (6) into position with a hammer.

It is important to make sure the Backing Boards are square with the left and right gables.

ASSEMBLY OF CAM SHELF



Step 1: Follow the below guide of which gable hole your cam shelf needs to be located. Count up from the base of the gable and using a Phillips head screw-driver to fit cam pins in.

Step 2: Put 4 cam heads into your cam shelf, turn it upside down and place inside the unit. Push the cam onto the pin.


Step 3: Once in place tighten cam grub screw by using a Phillips head screw-driver. Repeat for all four cams.



ASSEMBLY FLANGES & HANGING RAIL





Step 1: Tap flanges into predrilled holes for the Hanging Rail.

If you wish you can screw in a wood screw into the middle screw for a more secure fixing.

Then slide the Hanging Rail into both the left and right flanges.



Serious or fatal crushing injuries can occur from furniture tip over. To prevent this furniture from tipping over it must be permanently fixed to the wall with the included wall attachment devices.

When attaching unit to wall put safety bracket in middle of unit with 5/8 pan screw then 25mm pan head screw into wall. For plasterboard without a stud it is recommended to use a plug with screw (not provided).
