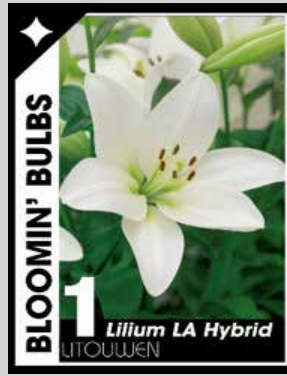


LILIIUM LA HYBRID FORZA



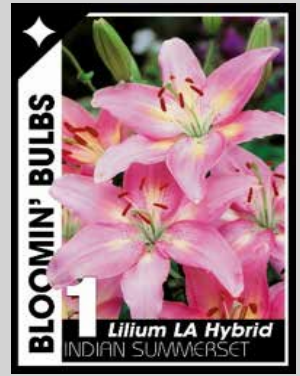

LILIIUM LA HYBRID LITOUWEN



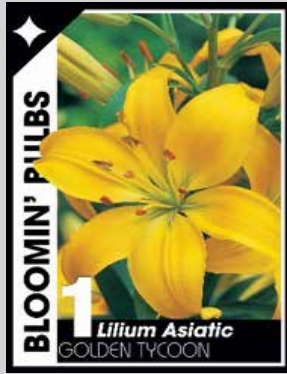

LILIIUM LA HYBRID INDIAN SUMMERSET



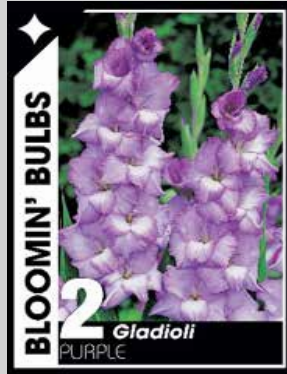

LILIIUM ASIATIC GOLDEN TYCOON



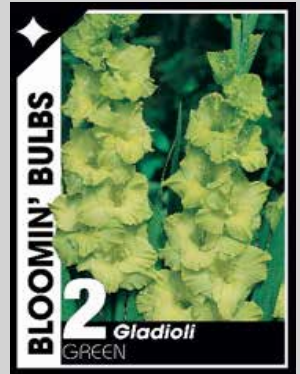
Asiatic Pot Lilies have shorter stems than the LA Hybrid and are ideally suited to cut flowers and colourful garden beds. Each bulb produces 4 to 5 blooms in summer. Protection from strong winds is recommended. Prefers a full sun position ideal for pots and containers.

GLADIOLI PURPLE



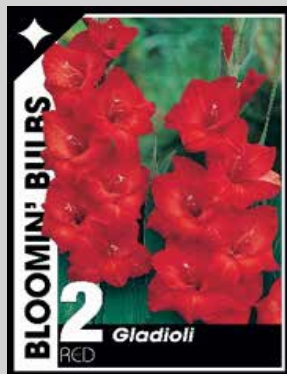
