#### **SURFACE PREPARATION**

NEW HARDWOOD	Ensure coated timber surface is dry, clean and free from dirt and debris prior to application
SOFTWOODS: TREATED PINE & WESTERN RED CEDAR	Ensure coated timber surface is dry, clean and free from dirt and debris prior to application
PREVIOUSLY PAINTED OR VARNISHED TIMBER	Ensure coated timber surface is dry, clean and free from dirt and debris prior to application
PREVIOUSLY STAINED OR OILED TIMBER	Ensure coated timber surface is dry, clean and free from dirt and debris prior to application

#### **APPLICATION**

EQUIPMENT	Brush
APPLICATION METHODS	Apply a thick coat by synthetic bristle brush. Do not exceed coverage rates. Take care on vertical or overhanging surfaces as Johnstone's Professional Timber Stripper may drip. Allow 15 – 20 minutes to penetrate and soften or wrinkle the coating. Stripping times will vary depending on the type of finish, thickness of the coating to be removed and age of the coating. Test with a paint scraper to ensure that the coating is easily removed. Remove old coating using a paint scraper or if appropriate, a high pressure water cleaner for large exterior projects. On timber surfaces, work in the direction of the timber grain. On curved, rough surfaces or mouldings, use a synthetic hard bristle brush or scourer. IMPORTANT: The stripper remains active while in a wet state. Do not allow Johnstone's Professional Timber Stripper to dry on the surface. For best results, cover with a plastic drop sheet to stop stripper from drying out and work in small area's at a time. Thick or stubborn coatings may require more than one application to completely remove. Sand as necessary to remove any residue before refinishing the surface. Clean stripped surfaces thoroughly with water and allow top dry.

STORAGE INFORMATION	Store in original container protected from direct sunlight in a dry, cool and well-ventilated area. Do not store below 5°C temperature. Keep containers sealed when not in use
	KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN  Avoid skin and eye contact. Provide adequate ventilation. If using inside, keep windows and doors open during application and drying time

ENVIRONMENTAL INFO	Johnstone's Timber Stripper is free from Methylene Chloride and NMP which are found in most traditional paint and varnish strippers. This makes Johnstone's Timber Stripper safer for interior usage and gentler on the environment when compared to these traditional strippers. Do not pour left over content down the drain. Unwanted material should be brushed out on newspaper allowed to dry then disposed of via domestic waste collections. Empty paint containers should be left open in a well ventilated area to dry out. When dry, recycle the container via steel can recycling programs. Disposal of empty paint containers via domestic recycling programs may differ between local authorities. Check with your local council first
VENTILATION	When using in an interior environment allow suitable ventilation
