

Mirror Installation Instructions

1-2 Mirror back Vinyl backing Double sided tape Leave a 10mm gap of silicone at outer edge Silicone 3 Spirit Level Front of Mirror

Installation Instructions

Mirrors

1. Ensure the back of the mirror and the wall surface are flat and free of dust.

Note: Please make sure you do not install mirrors on freshly painted walls, within 14 days of painting.

We suggest you use another person to help you install this mirror.

2. Apply double sided tape around the perimeter and through the centre of the mirror. Make sure double sided tape is on vinyl surface.

Apply a thick bead of Neutral Cure Silicone* down each edge on non vinyl surface, leaving a 10mm gap to outer edge.

Note: Please check Neutral Cure Silicone for curing times to determine when steps 4-5 may be completed.

- **3.** Using a spirit level, place mirror on wall applying pressure to all areas.
- **4.** To increase the life of the mirror, seal around the edge of the mirror the next day so that the internal silicone has a chance to cure.
- **5.** We recommend to prop mirror for 48 hours to avoid movement, and allow silicone to cure.
- ***Please note:** Use a Silicone that specifically states "Suitable for Mirrors".

IMPORTANT SAFETY INFORMATION:

When handling glass always wear gloves and eye protection.

Mirrors are manufactured from ordinary annealed glass and shall not be installed:

- · Where safety glazing is required.
- To any door other than to a timber wardrobe door.
- As a side panel to a door.
- Within 2000mm of any stairs (minimum 2 risers).

Mirrors must always be completely adhered to a solid backing (e.g. Wall, timber cupboard) in such a way that all pieces will remain bonded to the backing in the event of glass breaking.

The bottom edge of a mirror shall be installed;

- Not less than 500mm above floor level in a dwelling (e.g. house, apartment),
- Not less than 1000mm above floor level in a school or early childhood centre,
- Not less than 1500mm above floor level in an aged care building or nursing home.
