
# **BTCR9AU** Remote Control

### **INSTALLATION and INSTRUCTION SHEET**

fanSync Bluetooth receiver and hand piece included, allows 3 fan speeds and light control (supports dimming)

Free **fanSync** app available for some smart devices, allows 3 fan speeds, light control (supports dimming) and timer function






#### **RECEIVER ELECTRICAL SPECS:**

220-240V, 50 Hz, Max. 100W – Min. 15W (Fan motor)
Incandescent lamp: Max. 250W CFL: Max. 120W LED lamp: Max. 40W


### 1. Install the Bluetooth Receiver

**NOTE:** Fans with Pull Chains must be set to HIGH speed and light kits (if any) set in the ON position **CAUTION:** To avoid electrical shock, ensure electricity is turned off at the main fuse box before wiring

Step 1. Connect wires as shown in Figure 1



**Step 2.** Once the connections have been made, slide the receiver into the hanger bracket taking care not to pinch the wires (Figure 2)



**IMPORTANT:** The supply to the remote receiver should be connected through a mains isolation switch (e.g. existing wall switch). Do not use this product in conjunction with any variable (rheostat) wall control

## 2. Setup the Hand Piece

**IMPORTANT:** The Remote Control Hand Piece and Remote Receiver are paired at the factory and **DO NOT** need to be paired for standard installations or when changing the battery

#### **Basic settings for Hand Piece**

- 1. Open the back cover of the hand piece
- Dip Switches are preprogrammed at the factory to match the receiver and do not need to be changed in a standard installation
- Ensure the battery is correctly installed as shown in Figure 3. Battery will weaken with age and reduce the working range of the hand piece transmitter
- When using a light, set the Dimmer Switch to Dimmer (D) if bulbs support dimming, otherwise set to ON/OFF (O)

### Installing the Wall Plate

Attach the wall plate using the two screws supplied as shown in Figure 4





## 2. Setup the Hand Piece (cont'd)

**IMPORTANT:** The following steps are optional and do not need to be completed for a standard installation. Follow these steps only if replacing hand peice, receiver or controlling multiple fans with one hand piece

#### Pairing Process for Receiver & Hand Piece

Optional: Set desired transmitter code by pushing dip switches up or down

- Switch off power to fan (from isolation switch or fuse box) and wait 60 seconds
- 2. Restore power to fan and complete next step within 30 seconds
- 3. Press and hold the fan OFF button (a) for 1 to 3 seconds (refer to Figure 8)
- 4. The fan will turn off (if running) and then turn back on to medium

#### Controlling multiple fan receivers with one hand piece

- Ensure each fan has a remote receiver correctly installed
- 2. Choose one hand piece to use as the master remote
- 3. Complete the **Pairing Process** (outlined to the left) for each fan

# 3. Setup the fanSync App (optional)

Visit the Apple App Store or the Google Play Store to download the freely available fanSync app.

Complete these steps for each fan installed with a Bluetooth receiver

**IMPORTANT:** Bluetooth must be turned on in your smart device settings **NOTE:** Not all smart devices are compatible with the fanSync app, refer to Specification Sheet



**Step 1.** Open the fanSync app and tap the new fan to begin setup

**Step 2.** Give the fan a name and specify your fan's options

**Step 3.** Press Save and your fan will be ready to operate
