
Step '

Place bottom panel (E) upside down on the ground. Fix the castors with brakes (H) to the front half of the base and the two remaining castors (J) to the back half using the provided pan head bolts (O) as shown in the diagram opposite. Turn bottom panel back the right way and lock both front castors. Now slide left side panel (B) into bottom panel (E) making sure the tabs go neatly into the slots on the bottom panel. Then fix the left side panel in place using two self tapping screws (N) as per the diagram. Now repeat the same process for the right side panel (C).




Step 2

Slide back panel (D) into bottom panel (E) ensuring tabs on back panel insert into slots in bottom panel. Then attach back panel (D) to side panels (B & C) using self tapping screws (N) as per the diagram opposite.



Step 3

Place top panel (A) onto back (D) and side (B & C) panels. Fix all panels together using countersunk screws (M) as per diagram opposite Install shelf supports (K) into slots in all four corners at an even height and insert shelf (F).



Step 4

Place MDF board (G) onto top panel. Attach left and right doors (L & R) by inserting built-in hinge pins on doors into hinge slots on side panels as per the opposite diagram. Then insert wiring grommet (P) into pre-cut hole in back panel.
