

# TERRACOTTA SEALER

#### DESCRIPTION

Tileguard Terracotta Sealer is a clear penetrating solution that waterproofs terracotta tiles without leaving a slippery film coating. It is suitable for most unglazed surfaces.

TEST AREA. Always test on a small inconspicuous area, to ensure that the product is achieving the desired result, or that it does not discolour the tiles prior to application over the entire area.

## **SURFACE PREPARATION**

- Clean tiles and grout using Tileguard Tile & Grout Cleaner. Rinse thoroughly with water after cleaning.
- Remove and patch all loose or missing tile grout. For improved quality use Bondall Hydrocrete as an additive in the
- Application area should be dry for approximately 12-24 hours before applying Terracotta Sealer.

# **APPLICATION**

- Stir well before use, DO NOT SHAKE. Use a 25mm broad timber or metal paddle and stir with a lifting motion to incorporate the entire product.
- Apply one coat of Terracotta Sealer as an initial sealer coat and allow to dry for 4 to 6 hours. Apply a final coat of Terracotta Sealer to the entire surface.
- Apply Terracotta Sealer with a good quality paintbrush, applicator pad or spray.
- Do not apply if the temperature is below 10°C or if rain is expected within 24 hours.
- Ensure adequate ventilation during use.

# **COVERAGE**

Terracotta Sealer will treat approximately 5 square metres per litre depending on the texture, porosity and method of application.

#### **THINNING**

Not recommended









#### **GLOSS LEVEL**

Not applicable.

#### **DRYING TIME**

Terracotta Sealer will be touch-dry in 2 hours. Drying times are a guide only. Longer drying times may be required in cooler or humid conditions.

Allow drying for as long as possible before full use, light foot traffic is permissible after 4-6 hours depending on weather conditions at the time. Allow at least 24 hours before allowing heavy traffic. Optimum coating properties achieved after 7 days.

#### **CLEAN UP**

Clean all equipment up with water. Do not pour contents or washings down drains or sinks. Dispose as per your local council regulations.

Slightly yellow

#### **SIZES**

Available in 1 Litre and 4 Litre containers
