Acol Roof Window and AcolPlus Roof Window - Fixed and Opening

INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS - TILE ROOF

- 1.Inspect roof cavity for obstructions. Locating over hanging beams and under-purlins will require major structural alterations and is best avoided where possible.
- 2. From out on the roof, strip tiles away from intended location
- 3. Cut tile battens (and rafter if required) and nog out as required.
- 4. Fold down the soft flash that is tucked up at the bottom of the flashing tray and locate the window making sure you have a full overflash on the bottom row of tiles.
- 5. The tray can be fixed in place by tech-screwing through tray into battens (be sure to seal the screw with silicon).
- 6. Using angle grinder trim tiles to within 40mm of the awning. Ensure there is no fouling when the window is opened.
- 7. Before installing trimmed tiles, knock of the lugs off the underside so the tile sits flat over the flashing tray.
- 9. Finished window will have tiles over the top and side flashings with the bottom flashing and soft flash over the next row of tiles down.
- 10. There are four locating straps under the window these can be used to secure your window firmly to the underlying frame
- 11. Internal frame out should be to the outside dimension of the window frame. When gyprock or lining boards are installed this will result in a 10-15mm quirk.
