Application Guide

Surface Preparation

- Ensure all surfaces are clean, dry and free of contaminants.
- Any loose, friable and or water damaged surfaces should be removed and repaired.
- To achieve maximum adhesion and performance all surfaces must be dry prior to application.

Application Procedure and Equipment

- Due to the wide variety of surfaces a test patch should be applied prior to full application.
- AquaBlock is best applied with a good quality medium nap roller or brush.
- Apply AquaBlock following specified coverage rates leaving a smooth and consistent finish.
- To ensure maximum water resistance a second coat should be applied.

Precautions

- Do not apply if the temperature is below 10°C, if relative humidity is above 85%.
- Do not apply to wet substrates moisture content should be less than 15%. Check with a moisture meter if necessary.

Cleaning and Maintenance

Application equipment can be cleaned with water before product dries.
