



## RCS5050

MARNING: This Quick Start Guide is not a substitute for reading the operator's manual. To reduce the risk of injury, the user must read and understand the operator's manual before using the product.

## TO START A COLD ENGINE:

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Make sure the chain brake is in the "brake" position by pushing forward on the lever/hand guard.





Fully press and release the primer bulb at least 10 times.





Pull choke lever all the way out to the "full-choke" position.





When the temperature is above 10°C, pull the starter grip until the engine attempts to start, but no more than 3 times. When the temperature is below 10°C, pull the starter grip until the engine attempts to start, but no more than 5 times.





Push the choke lever all the way in to the run position.

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Depress the trigger release and squeeze the throttle trigger, then release the throttle trigger to

return the engine to idle.





Allow the product to run idle for 15 - 30 seconds.

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Before accelerating the engine or cutting wood, make sure the chain brake is in the "run" position by pulling back on the brake lever/hand guard.

## TO START A WARM ENGINE:





Make sure the chain brake is in the "brake" position by pushing forward on the lever/hand guard.





Pull choke lever all the way out to the "full-choke" position.

use cold engine starting procedure.





Push the choke lever all the way in to the run position. Pull starter grip until engine starts, but no more than 5 times. If engine does not start after 5 pulls,

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Depress the trigger release and squeeze the throttle trigger, then release the throttle trigger to return the engine to idle.

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Before accelerating the engine or cutting wood, make sure the chain brake is in the "run" position by pulling back on the brake lever/hand guard.
