


The Hozelock Easy Drip system has been split into three easy to understand sections:

A - Tap

B - Pipeline

C - Dripper





A - Tap

Connects your system to the tap

B - Pipeline

Carries water from the tap to the drippers C - Dripper

Delivers water to your plants

The tap connection is vital. It connects the watering system to the mains water supply. Always use a Pressure Regulator to control the water pressure to ensure the best performance.

Pressure Regulator (7022)

Key benefits:

A - Tap

- Reduces tap water pressure to 1.5bar (20psi) for optimum performance.
- ¾"BSP (G¾) inlet, 13mm or 4mm outlet.

Straight Connector (7017)

For extending 13mm supply hose.

Highly flexible, UV stable 13mm supply hose that carries water from your tap to individual drippers positioned around your garden.



T-Piece (7018)

For branching 13mm supply hose.

10m Supply Hose (2772)

transports water from your tap to individual drippers positioned in pots, containers and hanging baskets.

Seals holes in 13mm Flexi Hose when Universal Drippers are moved into a new position.

Adaptor Nut (7015)

Adapts the Universal Dripper to connect to both 4mm hose and existing Automatic Watering drippers.

- Allows for the connection of both Hozelock and 3rd party drippers to the Universal Dripper, ensuring complete compatibility.
- Easy to install providing a quick and water tight connection.
- Can be removed and re-used if required.

Peg (7020)

Sensor Controllers

The best time to water your garden, to avoid leaf scorch and excessive evaporation, is at sunrise or sunset, but it is not always convenient to be available to do it yourself at these times of the day.

The Hozelock Sensor Controller range of Automatic Watering controllers will take care of this for you, as they include a daylight sensor that automatically adjusts your daily watering schedule to start at sunrise and sunset. Both units are supplied ready to use with the most popular watering schedule of twice a day for 10 minutes; simply insert batteries to aet started.

There are two models available in the range, the Sensor Controller that automatically waters every day at sunrise, sunset or both sunrise and sunset. Alternatively the Sensor Controller Plus has the added functionality of selecting every day through to once a week.




