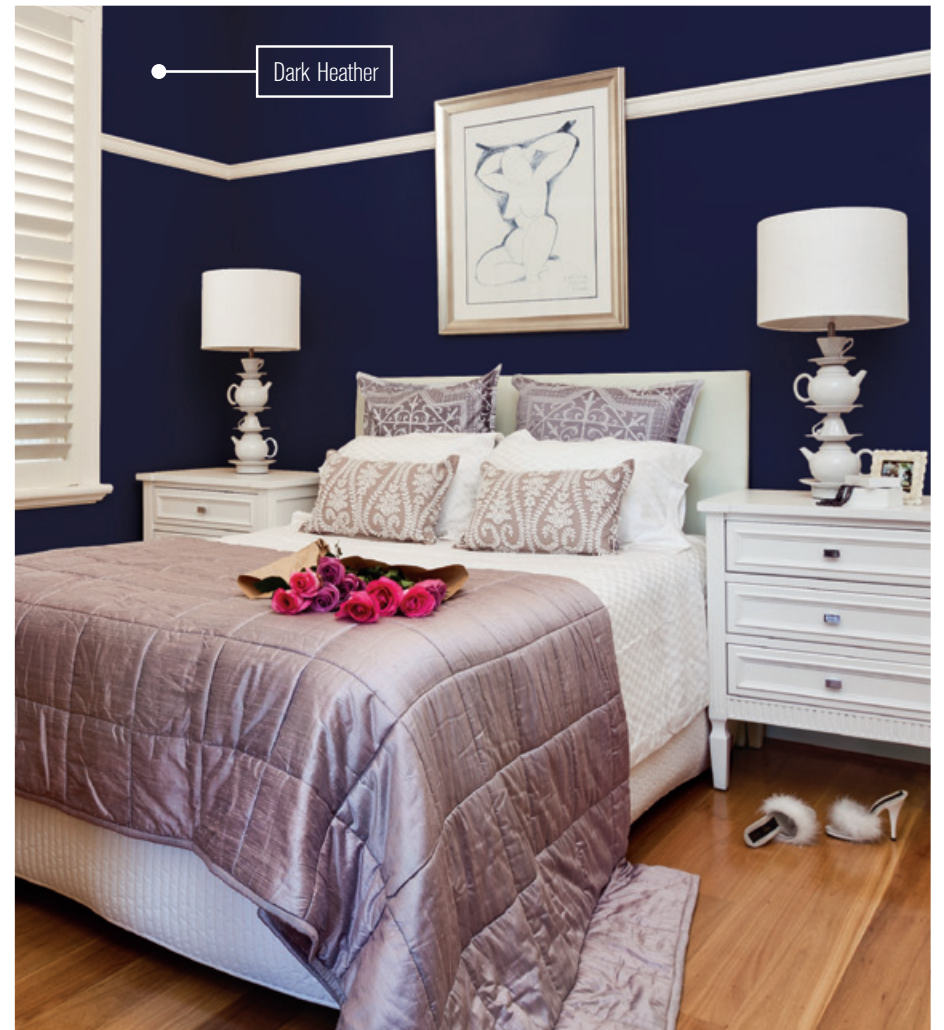
# Embrace colour

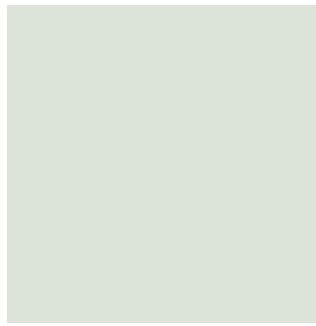
## Turquoise & Greys

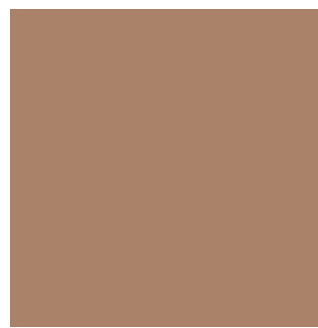
## Reds & Oranges

Sunny **Yellow** speaks **laughter and sunshine**, while **Green** balances **energy** as it's the soothing player in the colour wheel.

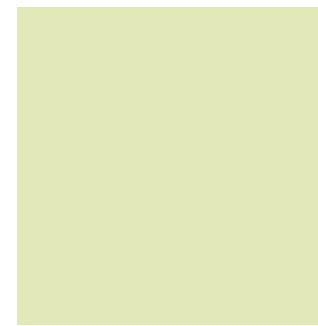


## Yellows & Greens

The **crispness** of cool greens of mother nature contrasted with **sunny yellows** gives an **emotional balance**.



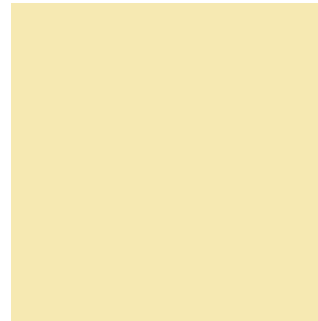

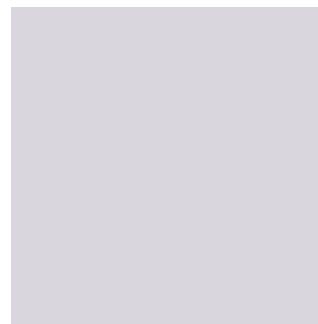
## Blues & Purples

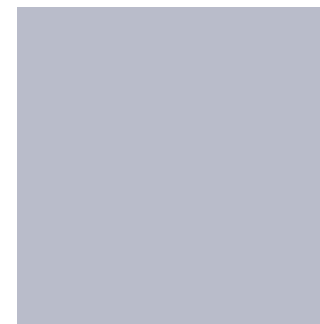

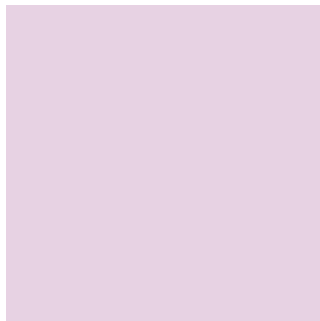

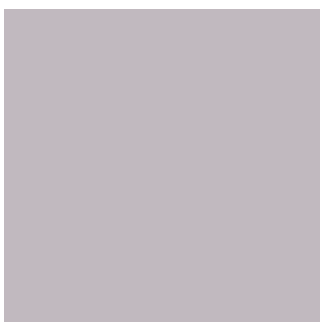
