















TYPICAL USES:

General repairs to bikes, boats, castables, vacuum-cast shapes, automotive bodywork and surfboards.

Provide extra strength and flexibility to fibreglass, metal and timber and other rigid substrates.

MATTING, CLOTH OR STRIPS?

Diggers Fibreglass Matting is ideal for general repairs and for reinforcing surfaces. It consists of yellow and white fibres bound together in strands.

Diggers Fibreglass Cloth and Diggers Fibreglass Strips use the same strands as matting but are woven rather than chopped, leaving a finish that is much smoother, stronger and more flexible.

Use Cloth as you would matting and use Strips to stick together to form a mat in differing thicknesses on uneven surfaces.

HOW TO MIX

Diggers Fibreglass Resin Catalyst is the hardener required to set Diggers Fibreglass Resin. Mix resin with catalyst: for 100ml of resin (cold day) use 2.5 to 3ml catalyst; and for 100ml resin (hot day) use 1.5 to 2ml catalyst. Use a measuring cup for the amount of catalyst needed or if using the dropper bottle 1ml = 45 drops. Mix the catalyst into the resin using a flat stirring stick.

HOW TO APPLY

Mix Diggers Fibreglass Resin with Diggers Catalyst, brush a thick coat of resin onto the surface and then position the fibreglass on top of the wet resin. Add another coat of resin taking care not to displace the fibres. (TIP: Dab rather than brush).

NOTE: When using or working on virgin foam ensure the foam is sealed prior to use as application of fibreglass (polyester) resin may dissolve the foam. Not suitable for epoxy surfboards.

Make sure that every part of the fibreglass is 'wet out' thoroughly and that there are no white spots (air bubbles). Use Diggers Fibreglass Roller to squeeze out any air bubbles, this will greatly enhance the finished surface.

Clean up with Diggers Acetone.
