
1. Assemble the Spreaders


- 1. Using a rubber mallet/hammer tap the Joiner into one of the Spreader pieces. Continue tapping until the centre slot in the Joiner aligns with the end of the Spreader and check that the hole in the Spreader lines up with the screw thread in the Joiner. If you've tapped it too far use a flat bladed screwdriver to carefully lever the Joiner out of the Spreader. Take care to not damage the painted finish.
- 2. Assemble the Handle to the Spreader and Joiner with one screw. This will keep the Joiner in position while you insert the other Spreader.
- 3. Use the rubber mallet/hammer to gently tap the second Spreader piece into position. Stop when it is flush with the first Spreader.
- 4. Insert the second screw and tighten.





2. Assemble the Legs







Step 3 – Rotate the Pivot to the open position and secure to the Spreader with screws (14 and 15).

Step 4 –Fit the Legs and secure with screws (13) and nuts (9). Repeat for all legs.


3. Install the Leg Braces




4. Install the Arms





